OSHA PROPOSES REVISIONS TO ITS RECORDKEEPING REGULATION

A proposed rule from OSHA amending its recordkeeping regulation would result in rescinding a requirement to electronically submit information from OSHA Forms 300 and 301 for those establishments with 250 or more employees. However, they will still be required to submit information from Form 300A.

One caveat of the rule is that it would help protect an employee's sensitive information from being disclosed under the Freedom of Information Act. OSHA claims that electronic submission of Forms 300 and 301 significantly increases the risk to worker privacy.
